POSITION OVERVIEW

The Advocacy Representative is an elected General Council position who represents the CSA and Asper Undergraduate Students at the University of Manitoba Students' Union (UMSU) Board of Directors meetings and the University of Manitoba Senate meetings. The Advocacy Representative acts as a liaison between the CSA, UMSU and the University of Manitoba. The Advocacy Representative works with the CSA President to identify the key elements and needs of the Asper Student body, and to advocate for these needs at the monthly University of Manitoba Senate and UMSU Board of Directors Meetings. The Advocacy Representative is also required to participate in other UMSU or Senate Council standing and ad-hoc committees.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend monthly University of Manitoba Senate Meetings.
- Attend bi-weekly UMSU Board of Directors Meetings.
- Advocate for Asper Undergraduate students at the University of Manitoba Senate meetings and at UMSU Board of Directors Meetings.
- Vote on recommendations put forward at the University of Manitoba Senate meetings and at UMSU Board of Directors Meetings.
- Communicate relevant information from the Senate and UMSU Council meetings back to the CSA Executive Council and CSA General Council.
- Join and participate in an UMSU standing or ad-hoc committee
- Attend monthly CSA General Council meetings.
- Promote and attend CSA events.
